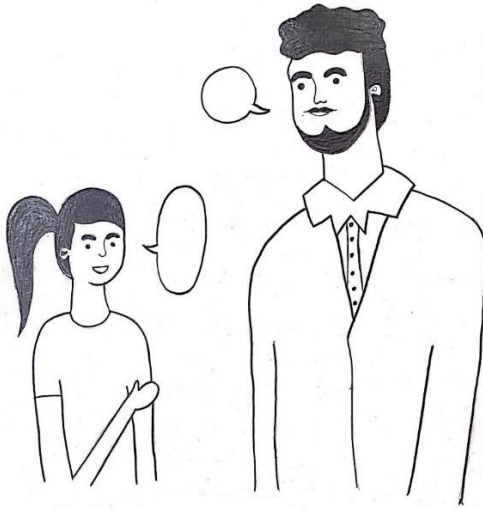

5.3 Pre-Production

Production Co-ordination

Everything was in order before the project entered the production phase: the first month's work was supposed to be completed before the project started; the production phase needs optimal resource usage, which is accomplished by running equipment correctly and arriving on time for the subsequent activity; all actions must be documented in order to ensure that the activities and every scene being shot are reviewed for any inconsistencies.

Post Production Co-ordination

It is possible to classify the processing of the raw material for appropriate use as postproduction. Comparable to assembling all the ingredients because it was so important to be resourceful, there was a lot of discussion regarding various facets of the project throughout the preproduction phase. The duties were carefully defined so that there would be no misunderstandings during or after the project's initial stages. Because there was extra professional job after this, the resources were always available, thus certain personal items were stored away, for a meal, and combining them to produce a delectable evening treat.

In the post-production stage, the short film "The two shades of life" was edited using Adobe After Effects, Adobe Premiere Pro, Illustrator, and Photoshop. One of the most crucial duties in this stage was to integrate sequences and, if necessary, sink voice overs with shots. Because editing takes a lot of time and effort, this phase was time-limited, which is why the project was finished on schedule

5.5 Camera Angles

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Keeping in mind that this is a short film, cinematic composition were made by employing a variety of camera angles and viewpoints. Establishing shots were used to distinguish between different locations. For the long shot and over the shoulder shots, two cameras were employed to shoot the sequences. Camera angles such as long shot, wide shot, close-ups, eye-level extreme close up, tilt up and tilt down some of the others shots used according to the need of the short film.

Lightings

Natural and artificial lighting were used because there were so many different settings and scenes. To provide depth and intensity to important scenes, vary dark lighting was used. In other shots shot indoors, flickers were used.

Location of Shots

The decision about the location of the shooting was very important for the message was quite close to heart. Some suitable places showcased the thoughts to be conveyed through this short film were studied after some significant brainstorming by highlighting the spots that were considered ideal for the plot. Mostly, the first part was recorded in a mall and restaurant, living room, lawn, car. These components were subsequently connected to a Shopping Mall and a luxury restaurant.
